


**To Vote:**

Enables establishment of 9-person Co-Op charter commission (5 from Hollis, 4 from Brookline), which will look at proposing a charter under RSA 197:5-b (Budgetary Official Ballot) that will enable all-day (and absentee) voting on all warrant articles on election day by official ballot. Proposed charter would come before voters in March 2027 for adoption. A charter with all day voting by official ballot will increase voter turnout and decrease voter disenfranchisement.
